I organized top clerics from each major religion (Catholicism, Episcopalian, Unitarian, Church of England, Islam, Judaism, Hinduism, Buddhism) to go into Iraq in coordination with UN High Commissioner for Human Rights and work with Iraqi Minister Tariq Azziz in developing a Truth & Reconciliation Commission and a Declaration of Human Rights at the same time that the UN Weapons Inspection was in process. We were within 30 days of visas and final arrangements for clerics and the program when Bush started the war; however, it now seems unlikely that the presence of the clerics or anything would have deterred the war intentions of George Bush, Cheney and their henchmen.

2006 – Present: Founded and operate Earth-Solar Technologies Corporation a renewable energy company that A) produces renewable energy technology (solar, waste-energy, fuel cells) and B) redesigns cities and nations to operate on those renewable technologies and sustainable social policies and cultural components (www.esolartech.com). Currently contracted to redesign 3 US cities, 2 African nations and over 75 megawatts of solar energy projects throughout the US.
