Ms. Wilson was one of the Founding Mothers, Chairperson, and Acting Executive Director, for the Center for Community Arts (CCA), in Cape May, New Jersey. The programs are intergenerational and targeted to low-income populations and minorities. Other programs of CCA include a Community History Program, a Community Outreach program, a Radio Station and the renovation of a historical black segregated school into a community center.

Ms. Wilson is also involved in Concerned Citizens of Whitesboro, Inc., William J. Moore Scholarship Foundation, GEMS of Cape May County, and N.A.A.C.P., major community organizations that raise scholarship funds for minority students. On the state level, Ms. Wilson serves as a member on the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Commemorative Commission, and the Minority Concerns Committee for the Superior Court of New Jersey.

Ms. Wilson has dedicated her life to developing beneficial programs to area communities that offer supports and solutions to targeted problems concerning minority populations. Everything Is Attitude, Inc. is now engaged in the development of strategies to empower under-served minority populations of New Jersey to optimize the myriad opportunities presented by a rapidly evolving “green” economy and to chart “pathways out of poverty”.
